This is the first time in the history of the University of Mumbai that the individual departments have been directed to hold ceremony to award degree certificates to their students, thus setting the precedent for this annual event.

This function was graced by the Chief Guest Dr.Sindhu Dange – Ex R. G.Bhandarkar Professor and Head, Department of Sanskrit, the Guest of Honour - Smt. Kiran S. Bajaj – Founder and President of "Paryavaran Mitra"and "Shabdam". Function started with University song and lighting of Lamp-Dr.Gauri Mahulikar (Head- Department of Sanskrit) welcomed guests and audience.

Dr.Madhavi Narsalay introduced the Chief Guest and the Guest of Honour. Dr.Gauri Mahulikar presented the department profile. She talked about the lateral progress made by the department in the last few years having started various courses in Mythology, Mysticism, Manuscriptology, Bhakti literature apart from the regular courses dedicated to Sanskrit. She then recapitulated the events of the past year in brief.

#### Speech by Chief Guest Dr.SindhuDange:

Dr.Dange addressed the audience in her capacity as the chief guest. She quoted from the ancient texts on Dharma that consider a well educated student as a sacred centre of potential value. Giving present day examples she urged the students not to lose touch with himself/herself in this fast paced world. Our ancient texts talk of the Ultimate Goal of a man's life is to seek the Ultimate Truth and Dr.Dange exhorted the students to stick to this goal no matter the circumstances. This was followed by the distribution of certificates to the students. Dr.Dange and Smt. Kiran Bajaj felicitated all meritorious students with utmost appreciation.

Significant feature of this programme was the felicitation of Mr.Alok Chopra. Mr.Alok Chopra, Commissioner Excise, student of the P.G.Diploma in Mysticism class was felicitated for receiving the Presidential Award for his services.
