

Bhartiya Shikshan Mandal

Bhartiya Shikshan Mandal started its work in the educational sector in 1969 with a view of awakening patriotism and nationalism. The mission of imbuing Bhartiya education with 'Bhartiyata' for national regeneration is - Bhartiya Shikshan Mandal. Shikshan Mandal is working in 26 states and 228 districts of Bharat based on these universal principles. Respect of the diversity and recognition and acceptance of the inherent oneness in the universe are the basic principles of Bhartiyata. Bhartiya Shikshan Mandal has developed a five dimensional agenda for this purpose – Research, Awareness, Training, Publication and Organisation. The aim is to enable society to rediscover the Bhartiya way of life and therefore recreate Indigenous Model of education.

RTMNU : Rastrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University was established in 1923. It is the biggest university in central India. It is accredited with grade "A" by NAAC. It consists of various courses such as Arts, Commerce, Science, Social Science, Law, Engineering & Technology etc.

NEERI : The National Environmental Engineering Research Institute is a research institute created and funded by Government of India. It was established in Nagpur in 1958 with focus on water supply, sewage disposal, communicable diseases and to some extent on industrial pollution and occupational diseases found common in post-independent India. NEERI is a pioneer laboratory in the field of environmental science and engineering and part of Council of Scientific and Industrial Research.

VNIT : Visvesvaraya National Institute of Technology Nagpur (VNIT), also referred to as NIT Nagpur, formerly Regional College of Engineering, Nagpur and Visvesvaraya Regional College of Engineering (VRCE). The institute has been ranked among the best fifteen engineering colleges in India. The institute was established in June 1960 and later named in honor of engineer, planner and statesman, Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya and in 2007 was conferred the status of Institute of National Importance.

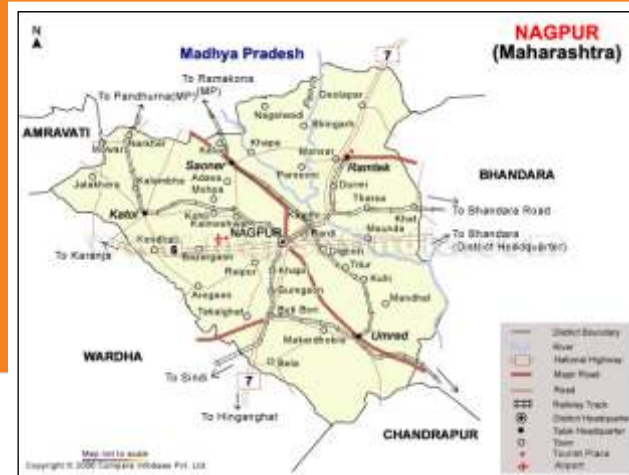
PDKV : Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Krishi Vidyapeeth, Akola was established on 20th October, 1969 with its head-quarter at Akola. This Agricultural University was named after the illustrious son of Vidarbha Dr. Panjabrao (alias Bhausaheb) Deshmukh, who was the Minister for Agriculture, Govt. of India. The jurisdiction of this university is spread over the eleven districts of Vidarbha. KKSU : The University was established on 18th September 1997. The place Ramtek, which is a township in Nagpur district, was selected because it is connected with name of great the poet of world, Kavikulaguru Kalidas. Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University has innovative academic programme and syllabus having modern subjects associated with traditional Sanskrit. On the one hand, the courses emphasis on modernity and on the other hand they strive to preserve traditionality. The University has special emphasis on Science and Technology in ancient India as preserved in the Sanskrit texts. The main objective of the university is to promote and propagate Sanskrit and allied ideological studies and to create leadership in this specialized area.

Nagpur is the largest city in central India and the sub capital of the state of Maharashtra. Nagpur has been identified as the best city in India by topping the livability, greenery, public transport, and health care indices.

Nagpur is also called the "Tiger Capital of India"[14][15] as it connects many tiger reserves in India to the world. It is among the important cities for the Information Technology sector in Maharashtra. Nagpur lies at the dead center of the country with the Zero Mile marker indicating the geographical center of India.
